## Vacancy for PhD Professor - Department of Policy, Management and Health of the School of Public Health of the University of São Paulo

The Dean of the School of Public Health of the University of São Paulo (FSP-USP) announces the opening call for three faculty positions (full-time), including one reserved for Black, Brown, and Indigenous candidates, specialty Public Health. Briefly, the position requires a commitment to teaching and extension activities and the ability to conduct independent research. Interested applicants should hold a Ph.D. granted or recognized by USP. Applications will be accepted between June 13<sup>th</sup> 2024, at 09:00 a.m. to August 12<sup>th</sup> 2024, at 11:59 p.m. (GMT-3). The entry-level monthly salary (MS3 level) is R\$ 15.498,97 plus benefits. The public exam will be held in Portuguese and covers the following program:

1. Public Health: definition, scope, perspectives and challenges;

2. Unified Health System: history, principles, guidelines, organization, and effects on the health of the population;

- 3. Teaching and training in Public Health in its constitutive or applied areas;
- 4. Public health preparedness: systems of information, intelligence, and response;
- 5. Public health surveillance: identification, control, and management of risks;
- 6. Disease prevention and population health promotion;
- 7. Public health needs: multiple dimensions of care and specific population groups;
- 8. Sociocultural approaches in the health-disease-care process of populations;

9. Inequalities, inequities, and intersectionalities in health: gender/sexuality, race/color, and social class;

10. Social, environmental, and commercial health determinants.

The entire application process - from the application to the result - will be ruled by the Brazilian constitutional principles, notably the rule of impersonality, and by the Statute and General Regulations of the University of São Paulo (USP) and by the Regulations of the School of Public Health.

All exams and assessments will equally consider generalist thematic applications in Public Health or those specifically aimed at one of its constitutive (Social and Human Sciences in Health; Epidemiology; Health Policy and Planning) or applied areas (Nutrition; Environmental Health).
